



### Officiating Appointment Opportunities for the 2016-17 Season

Biathlon Canada is seeking applications from officials who hold the formal qualification of Technical Delegate and who would like to be appointed by Biathlon Canada as the Technical Delegate (TD) or, as applicable, as a Referee for any of the following competitions:

- TD North American Cup #1 2016 Canmore, AB 2-4 December,
- TD North American Cup #2 2017 Quebec City, QC 7-9 January,
- TD North American Cup #3 2017 La Patrie, QC 13-15 January,
- TD North American Cup #6 2017 Whistler, BC 4-5 March,
- TD Western Canadian Championship Grande Prairie\*, AB 4-5 February\*, 2017  
*\*location and dates are tentative and may change*
- TD Eastern Canadian Championship 2017 Quebec City, QC 24-26 February,
- North American Championships / Canadian National Championships Prince George, BC 7-12 March, 2017

Qualified officials who are interested in any of these opportunities can send a letter of application to the Biathlon Canada General Manager, Andy Holmwood ([aholmwood@biathloncanada.ca](mailto:aholmwood@biathloncanada.ca)) by **October 10th, 2016**. One application may cover more than one event, but it must specifically list all the appointments being applied for.

Please note:

All applicants must be members in good standing of Biathlon Canada. Applications should not exceed two pages in length, and should highlight the following:

- Your officiating experience in the past 5 years - Regional, National and International
- Biathlon courses and education (both formal and informal), either taken or taught, in the past 5 years
- Your current Biathlon Canada Officials certifications and dates obtained
- What makes you a good candidate
- List of those events you wish to apply for

Considerations:

- For one of the Referee appointments for the 2016-2017 North American Championships, preference will be given to applicants who have never before been appointed by Biathlon Canada as a TD or as a Referee.
- Conversely, for both the TD and the other Referee at the North American Championships, preference will be given to very experienced officials who have previously held such appointments and who are well suited to mentor the “junior” referee appointee.
