



Canadian Hosting Policy 2017-18

Summary of Changes

4.1.3. Appropriateness of Competition Class

For all competitions covered by this policy, except for **Relay competitions and** the Masters Classes, competitors may compete only one Class higher in level of physical challenge than their age-determined Competitor Class (i.e. A Youth Man may compete as a Junior Man but not as a Man.)

4.4.2. Eastern and Western Canadian Championships

Registration for Eastern and Western Canadian Championships events may be made by Divisions, **Clubs, or individual competitors**. Registration by numbers, indicating competitors by class and the number of team staff members, must be made in time for the Organizer to make the necessary plans and arrangements for the Event. If the Organizer wishes to set specific deadlines for registrations, those dates must be stipulated in the Invitation.

1.2. PENALTY *(regarding Junior Boys and Junior Girls)*
